



Workforce lodge site update

We recognize the importance of listening to the community and making meaningful changes to our project where possible. We're proposing to increase the size of the project's planned workforce lodge site from an approved two hectares to seven hectares. This change is in response to community feedback and reflects our commitment to mitigating project impacts on the community.

An expanded workforce lodge site will ensure FortisBC can house the approximately 600 non-local workers expected during periods of peak construction, helping to relieve pressure on local housing, traffic congestion and other community resources.



Proposed workforce lodge site

We're proposing to build the workforce lodge at a previously disturbed site just south of Quest University in Squamish. Our proposal follows more than two years of planning, local engagement and site reviews.

This location avoids disturbing environmentally sensitive areas and provides workers with access to project worksites.

We want to thank those who have engaged with us on workforce accommodation to date and look forward to continuing our dialogue with the community around this proposal.
