

Environmental Protection Notice

Application for an Air Permit Under the Provisions of the Environmental Management Act

We/I, FortisBC Energy Inc. (16705 Fraser Highway, Surrey, BC), intend to submit this application to the Director to authorize the discharge of air emissions from a small-scale peak-shaving liquefied natural gas (LNG) storage and regasification facility in the Okanagan Region. The source(s) of discharge are air emission associated with the operation of two gas-fired water-bath vaporizer units.

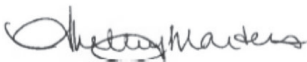
The land upon which the facility will be situated, and the discharge will occur is Plan EPP44270 Lot A District Lot 140, within the Regional District of Central Okanagan airshed, located at 1595 Spall Road in Kelowna, BC, within the City of Kelowna.

The maximum rate of air emissions discharged from the facility will be 47 tonnes per year of nitrogen oxides (NO_x) and 1.1 tonnes per year of sulfur dioxide (SO₂). The facility is expected to operate for a maximum of 96 hours annually.

The Project's operational air-emission sources consist of two gas-fired water-bath vaporizer units used to regasify LNG. Following regasification, the natural gas will be pressurized, odorized, and injected into FortisBC's natural gas system to support reliability during periods of high demand. Air-emission control is achieved through the use of low-NO_x burner systems incorporating flue gas recirculation, which are designed to reduce NO_x formation during combustion.

Any person who may be adversely affected by the proposed air discharge of waste and wishes to provide relevant information may, within 30 days after the last date of posting, publishing, service or display, send written comments to the applicant, with a copy to the Director, Environmental Protection at industrial.waste.authorizations@gov.bc.ca. The identity of any respondents and the contents of anything submitted in relation to this application will become part of the public record.
